His choirs have toured extensively throughout the United States, Canada and Europe and have received high acclaim for their musical artistry. Prior to coming to Delaware, Dr. Head served on the faculty at Westminster Choir College where clinical research resulted in co-authoring of the book *Case Studies in Music Education* published by G.I.A. Publications, currently in its second edition.
